Follow These Safety Tips for Tornado Season

Each year tornadoes kill or injure hundreds of people and destroy thousands of homes and other buildings. The winds of a tornado spiral around a wide funnel at speeds sometimes greater than 200 miles an hour. Spring is tornado season for the Midwest. The peak tornado time in Ohio runs from April through June.

Review this tornado information to stay safe this season.

**Tornado Watch**

When a watch is issued, conditions are right for a tornado to develop. Be prepared to take shelter and keep informed of the latest storm conditions.

**Tornado Warning**

A tornado warning means a tornado has been sighted and confirmed in the area. World headquarters employees will be notified by a long, even, monotone alarm. Take cover immediately in a designated tornado safe zone. Be familiar with the list of safe places to use for shelter in the event of a tornado. ► [WHQ Safety Guide](#)

The WHQ will sound the alarm only in the event of a tornado warning in Lucas County and inform you of any tornado warnings in the surrounding counties (Michigan border or Wood County).

Employees should always use the stairways, rather than the elevators, when moving to a place of safety. In the event of a power failure, elevators could be stuck between floors.

**What's Safe at Home**

Take shelter in one of the following locations:

- Basement or storm shelter
- A small, windowless, interior room like a closet
- A windowless bathroom. The bathtub and commode are frequently anchored directly into the ground, and sometimes are the only thing left in place after a tornado. Get into the bathtub and cover yourself with some sort of thick padding (couch cushion, blanket, pillow, etc.). This will give you protection on all sides, as well as an extra anchor to the foundation.

**In a Car or Truck**

Vehicles are extremely dangerous in a tornado. If the tornado is visible far away and the traffic is light, you may be able to drive out of its path by moving at right angles to the tornado. Otherwise, park the car as quickly and safely as possible – out of the path. It is safer to get the car out of mud later if necessary than to be stuck in a sturdy building.
